

P.A.R.K. POINTS: THE POSITIVE SIDE OF DISCIPLINE

Discipline plays a central role in life at Chamberlain-Hunt Academy. Faculty and staff recognize it as something sorely lacking in culture although it is a significant feature of biblical Christianity.

The Heavenly Father demonstrates loving kindness to his children by disciplining them. Jesus took on the *punishment* they deserve but not the *discipline* they need. God's discipline teaches his children to how live righteously; it protects them from sin and its disastrous consequences. Through his Word and circumstances, God corrects his children when they sin. He also blesses them in their obedience.

In 2004, Chamberlain-Hunt's commandant instituted **P.A.R.K.** as a companion to the Academy's Demerit system. Faculty and staff issue demerits to Cadets to correct bad behavior. Through P.A.R.K. points, faculty and staff now also reward Cadets, recognizing and reinforcing good behavior. As Cadets accrue P.A.R.K. points, they gain special privileges and rewards.

Cadets receive P.A.R.K. points for exceptional achievement in four areas of accountability:

- **Procedure/Performance** – P.A.R.K. points may be awarded to Cadets for consistent observance of customs and courtesies, the consistent maintenance of proper military bearing, specific acts of achievement, specific acts of displayed leadership, etc. These points may be awarded routinely by any member of the faculty or staff.
- **Appearance** – P.A.R.K. points may be awarded to cadets for consistent observance of the proper wear and use of the Chamberlain-Hunt uniform and standards of appearance. These points are to be awarded during daily uniform inspections or room inspections. The Tactical Officers or the Command Sergeant Major will normally award these points.
- **Room Inspection** – P.A.R.K. points may be awarded to Cadets for above standard cleanliness and care of their dormitory rooms. The Command Sergeant Major, the Commandant or the President will normally award these points.
- **Knowledge** – P.A.R.K. points may be awarded to Cadets on a daily basis through on-demand recitation of the question/memory verse of the week (questions will be taken from the *Westminster Shorter Catechism*) or through consistent, exceptional participation and conduct in the classroom. Any member of the faculty or staff may routinely award the points.
